Course Details

Apprenticeships take around 3 ½ years to complete and combine underpinning knowledge, practical workshop activities and workbased assessment. Apprentices normally attend college on a block-release basis to complete Technical Certificates along with Core Skills in Communication, Numeracy, Information Technology, Problem Solving and Working with Others.

Our Assessors will also visit your company to observe the practical skills of apprentices in the workplace and work closely with them towards gaining an SVQ work related qualification.



Accommodation

The college campus contains a purpose built 50 bedroom halls of residence. All rooms have en suite facilities, television and PC's with internet connection allowing apprentices to study during the evening after class.

The college food court provides a wide range of food and drinks from a simple cup of coffee to a full breakfast, soup and a sandwich or hot meal. Whilst our well stocked Library and Internet café enable our learners to access additional learning resources and study in a relaxed atmosphere.
